Vandalism Form:

All Teams participating in New York State Science Olympiad Tournaments must submit a copy of this Form signed by both the Team Coach and the Principal of the school. This signed statement must be submitted at the time of the Team's check-in on Tournament day.

"Vandalism" means a deliberate action that results in damage to property. This includes, but is not limited to, graffiti, damage to a facility property, and/or damage to the personal property of other participants, judges, spectators, etc.

If Team Members (or persons associated with the Team) commit(s) an act of vandalism, the Team may be disqualified from the Tournament and/or receive no points for a particular Event or for all Events. A Team Member (or a person associated with the Team) who commits an act of vandalism may be barred from future Tournaments.

Each school who sponsors a participating Team, must agree to pay the cost of repairing damage from any act of vandalism. A school must pay this restitution before it can register a Team for the Science Olympiad in a subsequent year.
