In concrete terms, below are some changes that may affect you in the upcoming Tournament Season:

1) NYSSO Team Registration:

Team Registration will open for all NYSSO Teams, on **Monday, September 1, 2025**. The Team Registration Fee will be **\$275.00 per Team**. Please visit our website to register your Team(s):

3) D Teams:

For the upcoming Tournament Season, D Teams will only be permitted to participate at Invitational Tournaments. This is in keeping with the Board's policy, which can be found here:

The Registration Fee will be \$100.00 for a D Team.

Also, please be aware that for whichever program is used at a Regional Tournament, a Student's electronic personal data MUST NOT be collected.
